ACTIVE CHEMICAL PROPERTIES	Sodium hypochlorite.
HEALTH EFFECTS	ACUTE
EYES	Corrosive to eyes. May cause permanent injury.
SKIN	Will cause burns to skin.
INHALATION	Vapours are an irritant and may be overwhelming.
INGESTION	Mildly corrosive. May cause burns to mouth, throat and gastro intestinal tract.
FIRST AID	
EYES	Hold eye lid open and flush eyes with water for at least 15 mins. Seek immediate medical help.
SKIN	Wash affected skin thoroughly with water. Seek advice if effects persist.
INHALATION	Move patient to fresh air. If effects persist seek medical advice.
INGESTION	Do not induce vomiting. Give water to drink repeat if vomiting occurs. Seek immediate help.
ADVICE TO DOCTOR	Corrosive liquid. Poison S5.
PERSONAL SAFETY PRECAUTIONS	Corrosive liquid. Always wear rubber gloves. Avoid breathing vapours.
SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION	
STORAGE & TRANSPORT	Store in original container in a dry place away from heat, foodstuffs and sunlight.
SPILLS	Wipe up spills with a dry cloth.
DISPOSAL	In accordance with Local Government Regulations. Packaging may emit noxious fumes if burnt.
